APG INVITES PUBLIC TO ANNUAL DAYS OF REMEMBRANCE OBSERVANCE

- Aberdeen Proving Ground invites the public to its annual Days of Remembrance commemoration 10 a.m. April 21 at the Post Theater.
- Guest speaker will be Felix Kestenberg, a holocaust survivor, who came to the United States in 1949. A native of Poland, Kestenberg was 18 in 1939 when war broke out and his life became a nightmare. He survived the ghetto, forced labor camps, including Sakoomomstrit, Blizyn, Auschwitz-Birkenau, Dachau and Waltlager, before he was liberated in April 1945.
- The Army Research Laboratory at APG is hosting this year's commemoration themed "For Justice and Humanity."
- Individuals without government identification cards requesting entry to the installation must register at the Visitor Center at APG's Maryland Gate on MD-715E off US-40. Each individual requesting entry must have photo identification, and the driver must provide registration for his/her vehicle.

- Photographs and film footage of the entry gate to the installation are prohibited.
