**AVERAGE COLLEGE COSTS 2003-2004**  
4-year public college with room and board, tuition etc \$13,833  
4-year private college with room and board, tuition etc \$29,453  
2-year colleges with tuition and books \$2,650  
Public 4-year colleges increased by 14% last year and private 4-year colleges by 6%  
2-year public colleges increased by 13.8%
