MEMORANDUM FOR Child, Youth and School Services Patrons

SUBJECT: Priorities for Care in Child, Youth and School Services (CYSS)

1. Department of Defense (DOD) has published implementation guidance on the priorities for care in CYSS. The intent is to provide full-day care to both military and civilian patrons.
2. Patron eligibility, as established by DOD Instruction 6060.2, remains as follows: all active duty military, DoD civilians, reservists on active duty or during inactive duty personnel training, and DOD contractors assigned to APG.
3. In order for APG to provide reasonable access to CYSS child care programs to eligible patrons, the priorities for care are as follows:

PRIORITY I:

- a. All single and dual military, deployed military with a working spouse (including reservists on active duty or during inactive duty personnel training).
- b. All active duty military (including reservists on active duty or during inactive duty personnel training) with a full-time working spouse or a spouse that is a full-time student.
- c. Army Wounded Warriors (AW2), Warriors in Transition (WT), and Family members of Fallen Warriors.

PRIORITY II:

Single DoD Civilians and married DoD Civilians with a full time working spouse or a spouse that is a full time student.

PRIORITY III:

- a. DoD contractors that work on the installation with a full-time working spouse or a spouse that is a full-time student.
- b. Retired military (part time programs & hourly care only).



SUBJECT: Priorities for Care in Child, Youth and School Services (CYSS)

c. All military, DoD Civilians, reservists on active duty or during inactive duty personnel training, DoD contractors assigned to the installation with a non-working spouse (spouse must find full time employment within 90 days of slot assignment to maintain a full-time space).

4. Placement of siblings will be based within the same sub-priority listing.

5. This action is in effect until rescinded or superseded.
