## Ravens, NFL Play 60 host clinic for APG youth

**ABERDEEN PROVING GROUND, Md.**— Baltimore Ravens players will host a special youth football clinic for children whose parents currently serve in the U.S. military Tuesday, Nov. 5, from 4:30 – 6 p.m. at Aberdeen Proving Ground.

Players scheduled to attend include LB Arthur Brown, WR Marlon Brown, S Matt Elam, LB Jameel McClain, S Jeromy Miles, LB John Simon, WR Torrey Smith, WR Denote Thompson and DT Brandon Williams. Official mascot Poe and Ravens cheerleaders will also be in attendance for the clinic.

In conjunction with the NFL's military appreciation Salute to Service and PLAY 60 campaign efforts, the Ravens will provide this opportunity to communicate to the military youth the importance of physical activity in their everyday lives. Through the continuation of the team's support for America's Armed Forces, the Ravens will host the clinic leading up to the Nov. 10 Veteran's Day game vs. the Cincinnati Bengals.

During the clinic, approximately 150 pre-registered youth participants, ages 7 – 14, will learn about the fundamentals of football with a military twist. Under the guidance of local football coaches and military personnel, the youth will rotate through stations of drills, including pass patterns, tire flips, heads-up tackling and a military agility run.

"Soldiers and parents at APG are truly grateful the Ravens and the NFL are bringing Play 60 to our youth," said Aberdeen Proving Ground Garrison Commander Col. Gregory R. McClinton. "We realize these players have a choice—and they chose to come here and say thanks to our Soldiers. More importantly, they are saying thanks to the kids by spending time with them.
